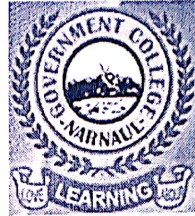

Briefing about the Survey

Student Satisfaction Survey is conducted every year to know about the students' perception about Teaching – Learning and Evaluation, which will help to upgrade the quality of process followed in our institution.

A questionnaire covering the wide array of skills involved in the teaching-learning processes through questions including How much of the syllabus covered in the class?, How well were the teachers able to communicate?, How well did the teachers prepared for the classes?, How teachers explain and demonstrate the concepts? Etc and it is distributed to the currently enrolled students of the institution. One descriptive question provides opportunity for the students to give their observation/suggestions to improve the overall teaching learning experience in the institution.

Around 1100 Students are randomly selected for the survey to maintain the objectivity in the entire process.

The students' response is recorded on a scale 0 to 4. Highest positive response is rated as 4 and the lowest negative response is rated as 0.

The response received by the students were analyzed and utilized for the improvement in the teaching- learning environment in the institution.

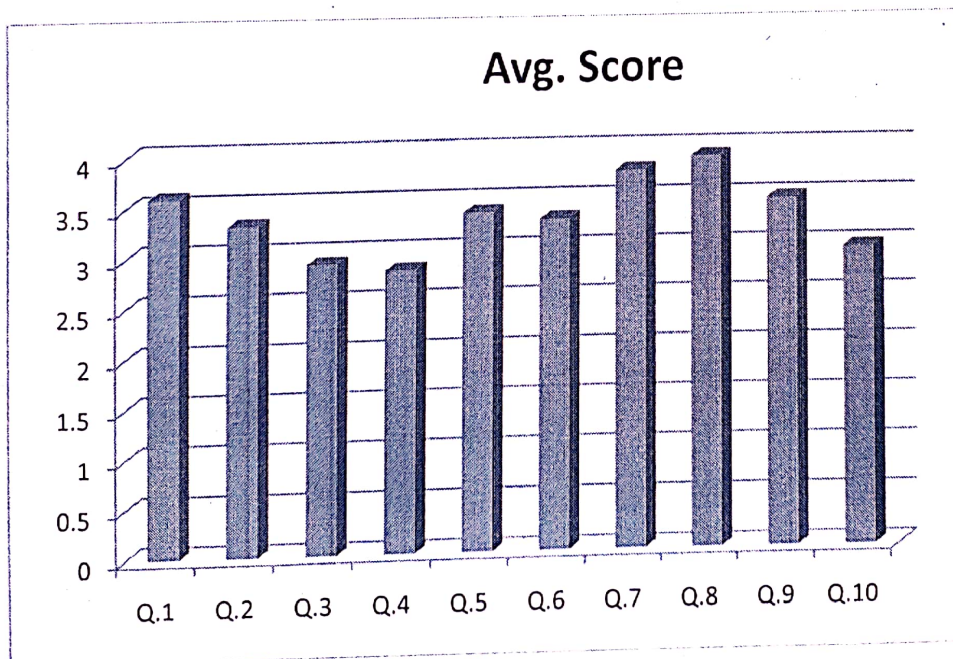
